

The Geneva School 2016-2017 School Supply List

Eighth Grade

Parents have the option of purchasing school supplies independently with their student or ordering Prepackaged School Supplies from the school (until July 1).

The following list is broken into two sections: items that are included in Prepackaged School Supplies and items that are not.

Included in Prepackaged School Supplies:

- 1 Package Mechanical Pencils, 0.7mm
- 3 Tubes 0.7mm Refill Lead, (30 leads per tube)
- 1 Eraser, High Polymer, White
- 1 Package Pens, Ball Point Black or Blue
- 1 Package Pens, Ball Point Red
- 2 Thin Highlighters, Yellow
- 1 Package Colored Pencils, Crayola 12-Count
- 3 Packages Notebook Paper, College Ruled, 150-Count
- 2 Packages Looseleaf Graph Paper, ¼" Quad Ruled, 80-Count
- 1 Composition Notebook, College Ruled (for English)
- 1 Package Expo Low Odor Markers, Fine Tip, 4-Count
- 1 Package Mini Index Cards, Ruled, 2½"x3", 200-count (for Latin)
- 1 Ruler, Metal 6"/15 cm
- 1 Bow Compass, Mapped Model 119410 (or similar)
- 1 Dialectic Sketch Book, 5½"x8" Hardbound, Pentalic, 110 pages (for Science) - From Art Systems (added 06/29/2016)

Available À La Carte through Prepackaged School Supplies

ESV Bible This item is needed by all students in 7th-12th grade. Many students already have an ESV Bible for school use, but if your student's copy needs to be replaced, you may purchase one À La Carte through Prepackaged Supply.

TI-30 Series Scientific Calculator This item is needed for 7th Grade math, and for 8th Grade science. Many students already have a scientific calculator for school use, but if your student needs one, it is available À La Carte through Prepackaged Supply.

Not included in Prepackaged School Supplies:

- Backpack (without wheels)
- Lunch Box
- Refillable Water Bottle

Billed to Accounts (These items will be provided by TGS in conjunction with the Dialectic Dynamics organizational seminar on the first two days of school. The associated cost will be billed to accounts in August):

- Customized TGS Daily Planner
- Binders
- Tab Dividers

Students in grades 8–12 are required to have their own device to bring to school for classroom assignments. Geneva does not specify a particular device—it could be a traditional laptop computer, an iPad paired with a keyboard, or a Chromebook. However, it must meet these basic (and crucial) requirements:

- A physical keyboard to facilitate writing
- A screen size of at least 7 inches, and no more than 17.3 inches
- A battery that provides a minimum of 3 hours of working time between charges (and preferably at least 6 hours). As an expectation of class preparation, the battery would be required to be fully charged at the beginning of each day.
- Ability to connect to Google Drive

In addition to their own device, eighth grade students should have access to the internet and a printer at home. They are given a Google Apps for Education account. This is the primary means for student writing and presenting through the year.
