Packing List

As you pack, please check the weather for Tampa (day one) and Lithia, FL (days one through three) on a weather app. Average temperatures range from nighttime lows of 62° to daytime highs of 88°.

LABEL EVERYTHING: including clothes, books, games, camera, towels, and luggage!

Your child must be able to carry his/her own luggage in one trip, so please encourage your children to follow the guidelines and pack lightly. We highly recommend a small suitcase or a duffel bag.

Students should come to school wearing their Red TGS polo and uniform bottoms

- ♦ Sleeping bag, twin fitted sheet, & pillow
- ♦ Bible and pen
- ♦ Reusable water bottle
- ♦ Flashlight
- ♦ Sunscreen/bug spray
- ♦ Small backpack for the bus
- ♦ Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, shampoo, soap)
- ♦ Two thin towels
- ♦ Cedarkirk t-shirt for second day
- ♦ TGS Spirit shirt for third day
- ♦ Water shoes/shirt and uniform mesh shorts for canoeing and shark tooth hunting
- ♦ 2~3 pairs of long pants/shorts/capris (depending on the weather forecast)
- ♦ 2-3 t-shirts for evenings
- ♦ Comfortable tennis shoes or walking shoes that are easy to take on and off
- ♦ Flip flops for the shower
- ♦ Pajamas
- ♦ Underwear and socks for three days
- ♦ Rain poncho/rain coat depending upon weather forecast
- ♦ Plastic trash bags for dirty/wet clothes
- ♦ Card games, books, and small games/activities to keep you busy on the bus (remember, no electronic devices of any kind, even Kindles or E-readers)
- ♦ Jacket/sweatshirt, one with a hood is recommended
- ♦ Camera w/extra batteries or charger (optional)

Medications

We will have First Aid Kits with us and will administer acetaminophen, ibuprofen, Benadryl, Tums, or Dramamine to a student only if the parent has given permission on the Cedarkirk Medical Form. If a student is bringing medication with them for the trip nurse to administer, the parent should deliver this to the trip nurse at drop off on the first morning. Medications must be in original containers labeled with the child's name and dosage instruction. Please put medications in a labeled Ziploc bag. Students with inhalers and/or EpiPens should keep one with them at all times and give a second one to the trip nurse.
